



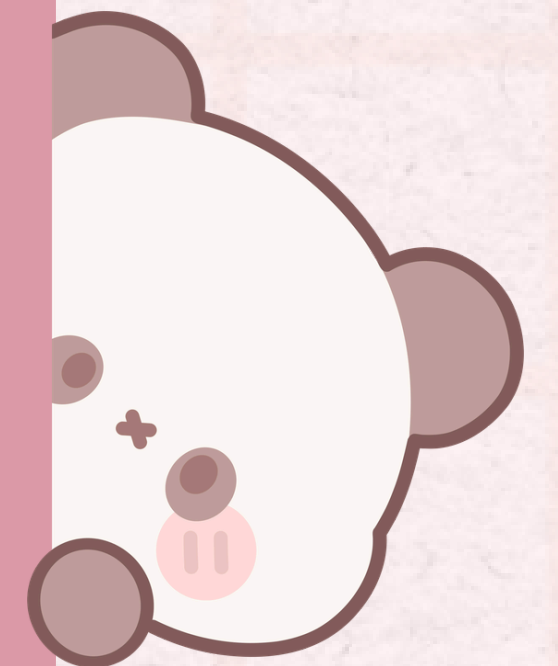
Sink or float?

- Objects that's crumbled up, like a piece of paper rounded up is more likely to sink.

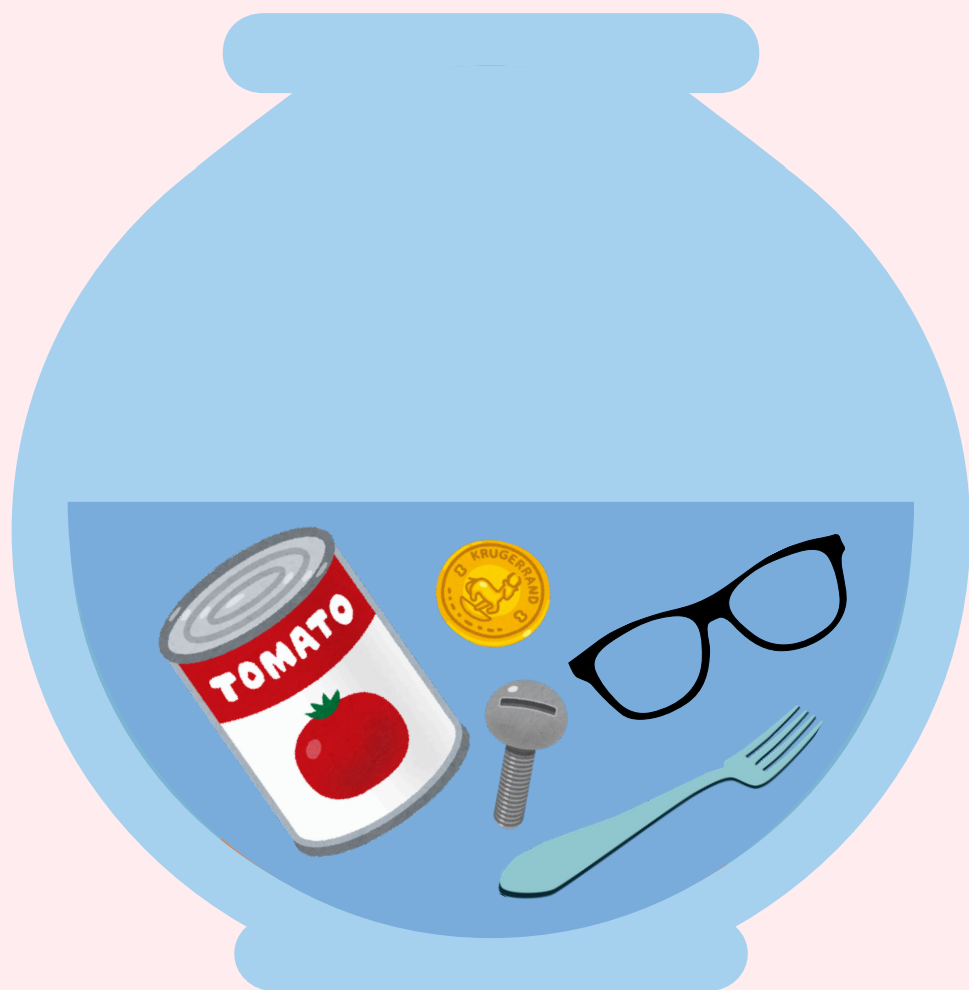
