



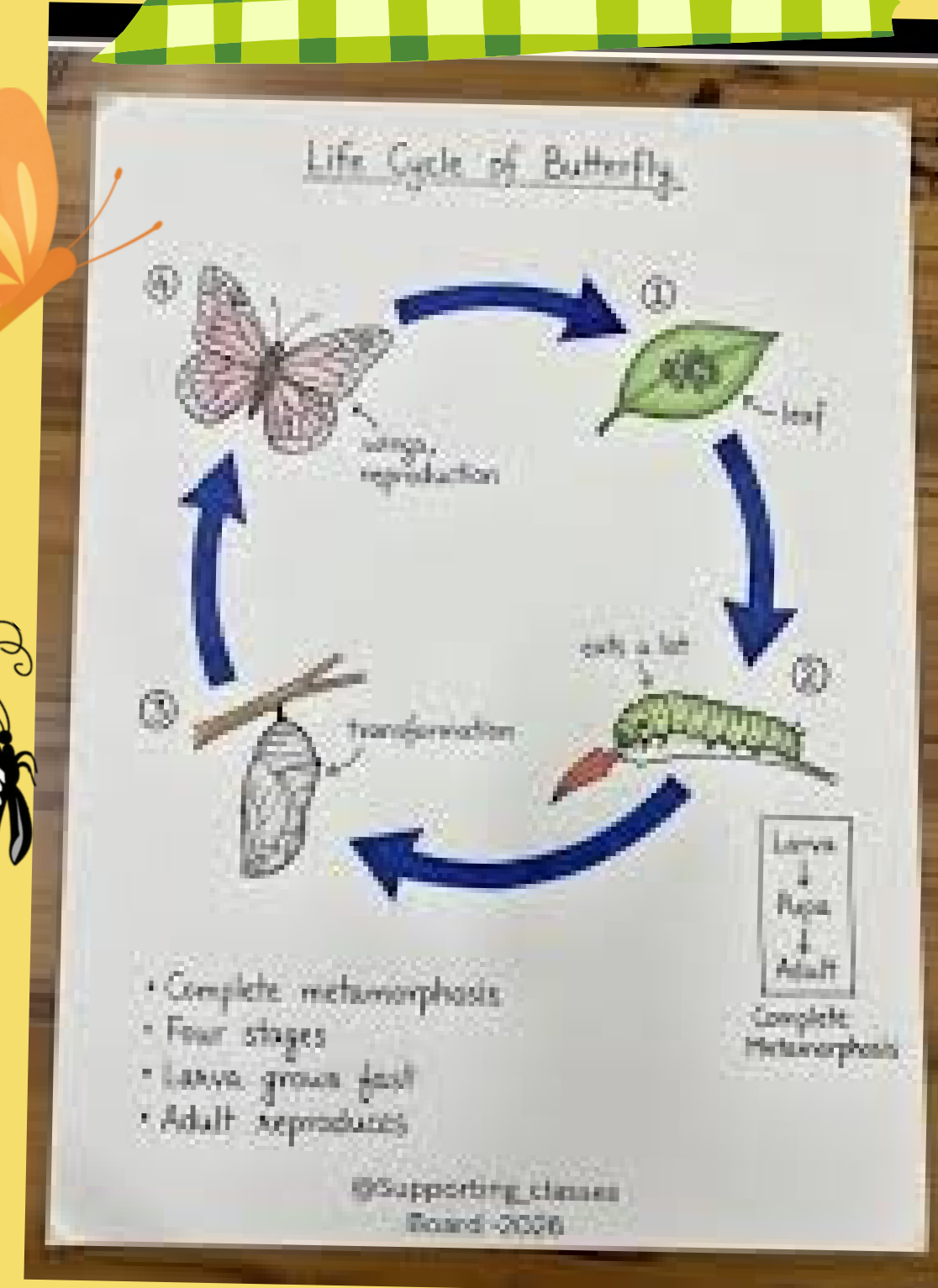

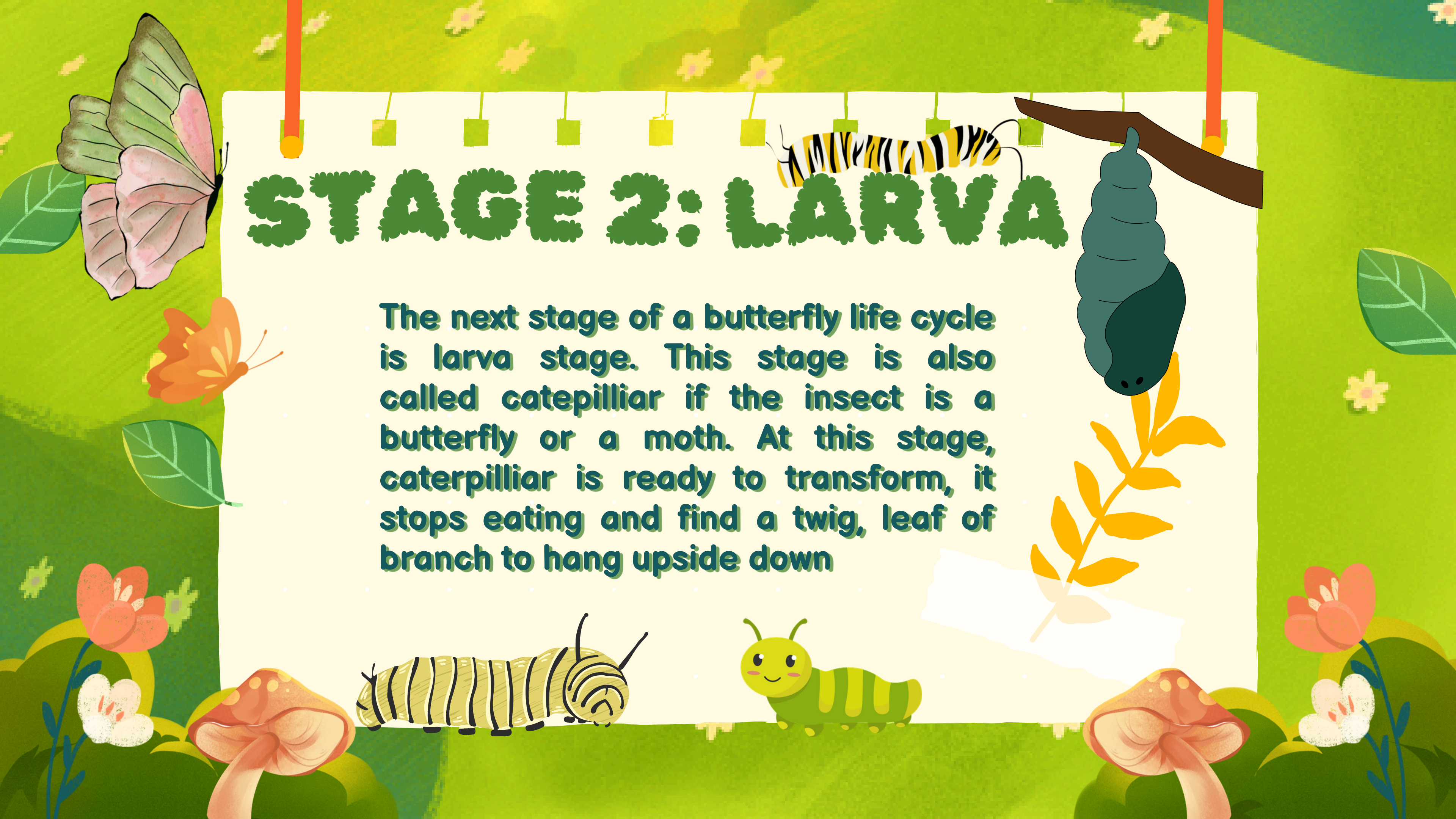
What is the life cycle of a butterfly?



STAGE 1: EGG

The eggs are laid on a leaves of plants. When the eggs are hatched, this plant can be used as food for the caterpillars. Eggs are usually laid on spring and summer. On average, the size of the butterfly egg is roughly 1-3 millimeters in diameter. The egg hatch in 2-4 days





STAGE 2: LARVA

The next stage of a butterfly life cycle is larva stage. This stage is also called caterpillar if the insect is a butterfly or a moth. At this stage, caterpillar is ready to transform, it stops eating and find a twig, leaf of branch to hang upside down



When the caterpillar is full-grown and stops eating, it becomes a pupa. The pupa of butterflies is also called a chrysalis. They may be suspended from a branch or leaf. Some species find a hidden spot on the ground or even go underground. This stage can last from a few weeks to a few months

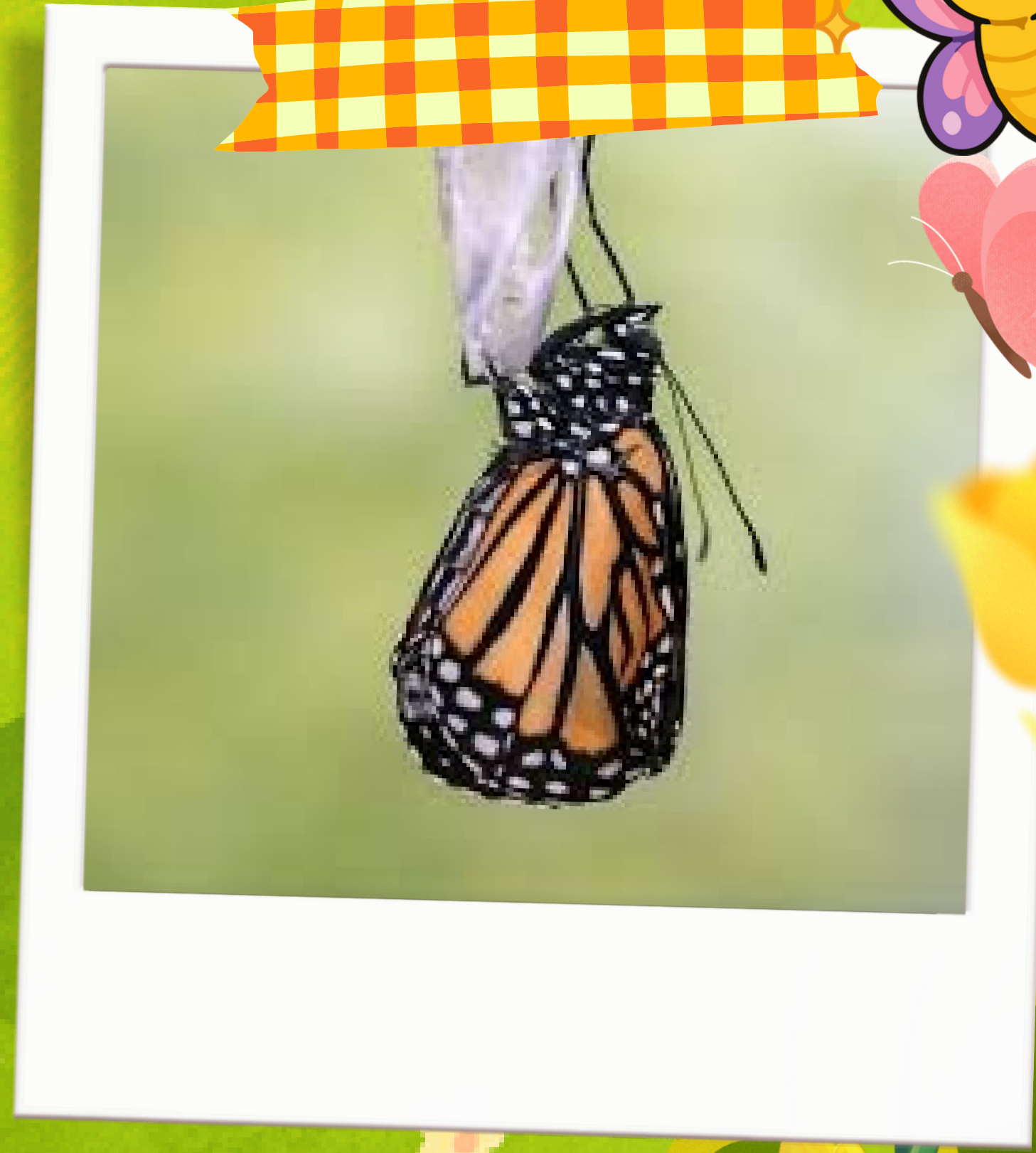
STAGE 3: PUPA



STAGE 4: ADULT

Once the adult has emerged from the chrysalis, they are fully developed butterflies. Most adult butterflies live only one or two weeks, but some species hibernate during the winter and may live several months.

The adult's job is to mate and lay eggs.
